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Dear participating teams,



1. WELCOME TO SERBIA!

1.1. INTRODUCTION OF THE HOST COUNTRY

Serbia has connected West with East for centuries – a land in which civilizations, cultures, faiths, climates and landscapes meet and mingle. Serbia is a crossroads of Europe.

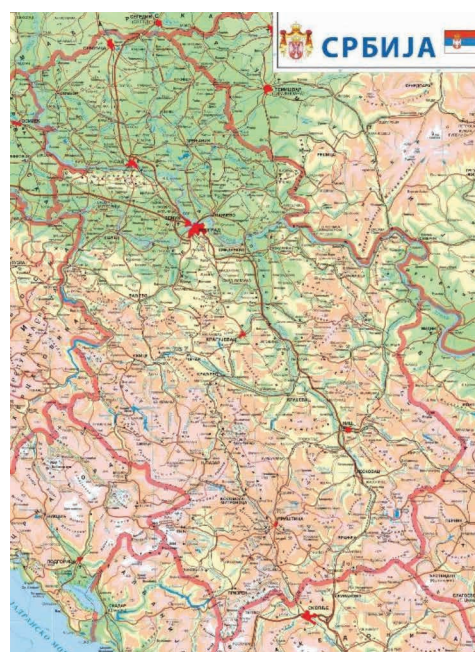

1.2 THE CITY OF NIS

Niš is the third-largest city in Serbia and the administrative center of the Nišava District. According to the 2011 census, the urban area of Niš has a population of 187,544, while the administrative area has a population of 260,237 inhabitants. It is one of the oldest cities in the Balkans and Europe, and has from ancient times been considered a gateway between the East and the West.

It was founded by the Scordisci in 279 BC after the invasion of the Balkans. The city was among several taken during the Roman conquest in 75 BC; the Romans constructed the Via Militaris through the city in the 1st century, and it is also the birthplace of Constantine the Great, the first Christian Emperor and the founder of Constantinople, as well as Constantius III and Justin I. It is home to one of the oldest churches in Serbia, dating back to the 4th century, in the suburb of Mediana. During the partition of the Roman Empire it fell under the control of the Byzantine Empire. In the 6th century Slavic tribes began settling the Balkans; the town was held by the Byzantines until the 9th century when it fell under Bulgar rule. Authority over the city was contested until the Byzantines eventually granted

the city to the Serbs in the 12th century. Niš served as Stefan Nemanja's capital. It was conquered by the Ottomans in the 15th century, becoming the seat of a sanjak initially in Rumelia Eyalet (1385-1443, 1448-1846), then in Niš Eyalet (1846-1864) and finally in Danube Vilayet (1864-1878). It was conquered by the Serbian Army in 1878 during the Serbian–Ottoman War (1876–78).



Niš is one of the most important industrial centers in Serbia, especially in the electronics, mechanical engineering, textile, and tobacco industries. Niš Constantine the Great Airport is its international airport. In 2013 the city was host to the celebration of 1700 years of Constantine's Edict of Milan. The town was named after the Nišava River, which flows through the city and which was named Navissos by the Celtic in the 3rd century BC; from this term comes the Roman Naissus, Byzantine Nysos and Slavic Niš. Legend has it that Niš was founded by a Prince Nisa, who built it using the nearby HumškaČuka stone. It has been called The Emperor's City. The name is sometimes rendered as Nish or Nissa in English.

2.1 SC CAIR

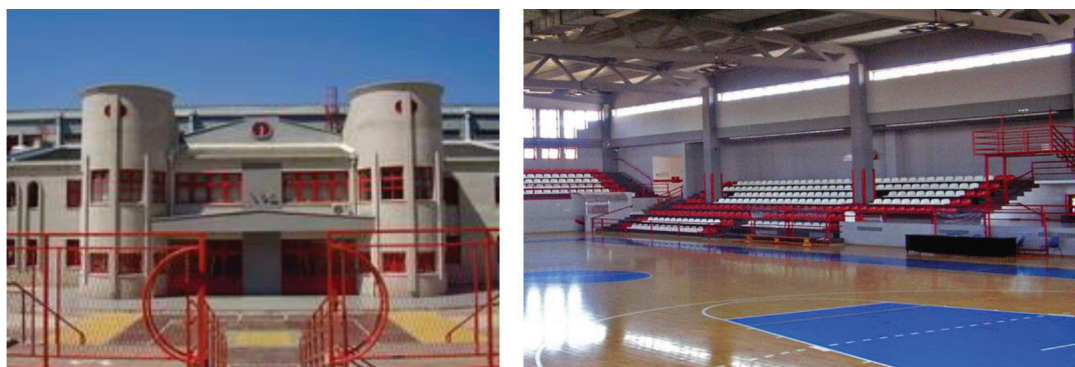
SC Cair is a sports complex that was completely reconstructed in 2011. It has been used for various sports competitions, national and international, but it is well-known for hosting our National Basketball Cup competition “Radivoj Korac” for many years. One group of FIBA Women’s EuroBasket 2019 was organized in this venue.

The capacity for sports events is 4000 seats, with 8 changingrooms, press zone, offices, auxiliary hall...



2.2 OS MIKA ANTIC

Sports hall Mika Antic has been opened in 2006 and renovated in 2023. It has been used for national competitions in many sports. Being renovated for this competition, with the capacity of 1100 seats and many changing rooms, this venue has been put in focus for basketball.

The Host team can choose the game time in the Group Phase for all its games and in the direct Elimination Phase if still competing for medals. This does not apply for the final day.

Relegation: The three (3) teams classified 14th - 16th will be relegated to Division B. This relegation will take effect the following year at the same age category competition.

Exception: The Board of FIBA Europe decided at its meeting on 17th March 2023 to award the FIBA U18 European Championship 2024 to the National Federation of Finland. As a consequence, and as per decision of the Board of FIBA Europe from its meeting in May 2015 in Malta, the U18 National Team of Finland will be excluded from Relegation in 2023.

This means that should FIN finish 14th to 16th in this tournament, only two (2) teams will be relegated from the FIBA U18 European Championship in 2023.

4.1 WELCOME DESKS

Welcome desks will be situated in the lobbies of the hotels. Delegations will be able to get all necessary information at the Welcome desks, which will facilitate their stay in Nis.

4.2 MEETING ROOMS

Meeting rooms will be provided for the teams' use free of charge. Requests for meeting rooms reservations should be made using the team Daily Activity Form which will be provided to the Team Attaches on a daily basis (see also the Annex 2 of this Bulletin), but necessarily one day ahead. We strongly encourage teams to use this Form for fast and clear communication and organization.

4.3 ADDITIONAL ACCOMMODATION COSTS

In accordance with FIBA Europe Competitions Regulations, teams will be provided accommodation for 18 persons in 6 double and 6 single rooms at the Host's expense as well as the accompanying referees.

Teams are requested to fill out the attached Annex 1 (arrivals, departures and additional rooms) **by JUNE 25, 2023 at the latest and send it to accommodation@kss.rs**

Should the team have the request for accommodating the extra in addition to the 19 members of delegation (including the referee), it will be charged as follows

140EUR - single room, full board per person per day

200 EUR - double room, full board per room per day.

All extra payments must be transferred to the bank account along with the Contribution fee (see below).

5. LOCAL TRAVEL & TRANSPORTATION

5.1 ARRIVAL INFORMATION

All teams arriving to Belgrade Airport (BEG) Nikola Tesla will be welcomed by Host transport staff in the arrivals hall. A roll up display will be positioned in the arrivals area of Belgrade Airport, just after Customs.

The distance from Belgrade Airport Nikola Tesla to Nis is 250 km that is 2 hr 40 min drive.

Please note that there is Nis Constantine the Great Airport with a certain number of flights to several countries, so we suggest you to check out the possibility of travelling directly to Nis from your respective country.

5.2 TEAMS TRANSFERS

All team delegations are expected to arrive on July 20th and depart on July 31st , 2023. The Hostis responsible for teams' transportation from Belgrade Airport Nikola Tesla, in accordance with their arrival schedule, to Nis on July 20th and back to Belgrade Airport Nikola Tesla, in accordance with their departure schedule, on July 31st.

Transportation will be organized by the Hostfor all teams from the respective hotel to/from the venue for games and practices as well. The transportation schedule will be available at the Welcome desks in team hotels.

Should the team place the request for any additional transfer, apart from stated above, it will be charged in accordance with the following price list:

- Belgrade-Nis or Nis-Belgrade by bus (50 seats) – 500 EUR
- Belgrade-Nis or Nis-Belgrade by mini-bus (20 seats) – 400 EUR
- Belgrade-Nis or Nis-Belgrade by mini-van – 250 EUR
- Belgrade-Nis or Nis-Belgrade by car – 200 EUR

6. TEAM SERVICES

6.1 MEDICAL SERVICES

Comprehensive medical service will be provided by the Host(including 24-hour emergency assistance) for all participants accredited for the competition in each venue in case of an illness and/or accident during their official stay in the competition.

An emergency medical service consisting of 2 paramedics and an ambulance will be present at each game venue during all games and practices.

The costs of diagnostic and medical service sand/or treatments, equipment and rehabilitation facilities listed below are approximate:

X-ray - 50 EUR; MRIscan - 200 EUR; Localdentist - 50 EUR; Physiotherapist - 40 EUR; Massage therapist - 30 EUR.

6.2 WATER

Plastic bottles with drinking water in sufficient quantities will be provided to the teams at the competition venues during games and practices during the official Championship period (from the first to the last day of the competition plus two days).

6.3 ICE

Ice will be made available at the competition venues. All logistics and details about the ice provision will be communicated at the Technical Meeting.

6.4 TOWELS

The Host shall provide each team with 12 towels per team and per game.

6.5 LAUNDRY SERVICE

Laundry expenses are to be covered by the teams and will be provided at a reasonable price for each team delegation. The Host will arrange the laundry service at a special rate which will be communicated at a later stage.

The Hostwill assist in case that the team wishes to organize this service on its own.

6.6 MASSAGE TABLES

Massage tables will be provided free of charge in changing rooms in both venues. Additionally, should the team wish to rent extra massage tables, the Hostcan provide them upon request and for 30 EUR per day per table.

7. TECHNICAL MEETING

The Technical Meeting shall take place at the **Crystal Ice Hotel on July 21st at 19:00.** Maximum two (2) representatives of each Team Delegation, the FIBA Technical Delegate and/or FIBA Commissioner, FIBA Staff, FIBA Supervisory Doctor, Host Event Director and necessary Host Staff shall attend the meeting. All participating teams must have a representative fluent in English present at the Technical Meeting.

The representatives of the delegations are responsible for bringing to the meeting the following:

- Final Team Delegation roster from MAP.
- Passports of all twelve (12) players, all coaches and accompanying team delegation members.
- Collective Entry Forms duly signed by all twelve players (incl. parents' signature for minors), all coaches and delegation members.
- One (1) sample set of each uniform (dark and light) and one (1) warm-up/shooting shirt.

The written invitation for the Technical Meeting will be sent by the Host to the heads of delegations, so please do provide us with his/her contact e-mail by **June 25th.**

8. CONTRIBUTION FEE

Each delegations shall be composed of 12 players and 7 other persons including head coach, team doctor, accompanying referee and the head of delegation. Each team must pay a contribution towards its staying expenses to the Local Organizing Committee (Host) in the amount of EUR 50 per person per day for the duration of the competition plus 2 (two) days.

Example: Tournament days are 22nd - 30th July 2023 (9 days) plus 2 days = total of 11 nights.

19 persons x 11days x EUR 50 = EUR 10,450

9. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

9.1 HEADSHOT SHOOTING

Please note that FIBA Europe will be taking headshots of the players and coaching staff of all teams. The headshots, and further individual and group photos, will be used for the official website as well as archive purposes, and will be made available to all teams, if needed. The photo shooting will be conducted one day before the start of the event.

The exact location and a detailed schedule, taking into account the practice times, will be sent to all teams in due course. Please note that the players shall wear the official game jerseys (dark color, including shoes) and the coaches shall be uniformly dressed in official team gear (polo shirt, tracksuit jacket or similar).

A photograph of each team will be taken on the court prior to its first game of the Event. The timing will be specified in the Game Run Down. Photographs will be taken from the center circle with each team standing in their official game uniforms (no warm-up T-shirts etc.) on their respective free-throw line, with number clearly visible.

9.2 REFEREE INSTRUCTORS AND COACHES MEETING

9.3 LIVE STREAMING AND GAME VIDEOS

All games of the FIBA U18 European Championship will be streamed live on the official FIBA YouTube Channel. Copies of all games will be available for the teams upon their request. USB stick will be provided by the Host to all teams at the Technical Meeting.

The Host will be ready to produce, via USB or hard drive, a copy of each game of the tournament upon request. The price is 120 euro for all games in the competition. The said amount should be transferred to the Host together with the team's contribution fee.

10. ACCREDITATIONS

Each team will receive a maximum of 25 (twenty-five) accreditation cards for the members of the delegation. Out of those 25 (twenty-five) accreditation cards, only 21 (twenty-one) are with court access and 2 (two) of them are VIP accreditation cards with relevant access.

Team accreditation cards will be issued during the Technical Meeting once the final roster and the list of delegation are confirmed by the commissioner.
